Blind Date: Adele Mills “Solo Show”

November 29 – December 7, 2008

This exhibition is a continuing project investigating the biological phenomena of “filling-in” of the void or blind-spot in our vision. By merging two systems of knowledge, art and science, Mills uses a bio-medical artifact of measurement and creates a vast archive of her own blind-spots. Systematically mapping out, recording and accumulating them into small paintings that are strung together onto long vertical strips of vellum. Disrupting the highly coded language of science and literalizing the small bits of absence suggests an alternative site for knowledge construction.

Adele Mills received her MFA in Fine Art from California Institute of the Arts. She lives and works in Los Angeles, Ca.
